### **National Sovereignty and the Principle of Primacy in EU ...**

The principle of primacy of the EU law has been in force for almost 50 years and belongs to the funda-mental principles of EU law It signifies that in case of a conflict between EU law and the law of the Member States, the EU law prevails Its fundamental goal is to assure a unified and effective application of EU law in all Member States

### **How does EU law apply in the UK after Brexit?**

EU law currently applies in the UK - is due to be repealed on exit day<sup>5</sup> 'Exit day' is defined as 31 January 2020<sup>6</sup> This would mean that directly effective EU law - such as EU regulations - would cease to have effect in the UK and the subordinate legislation made under the ECA 1972 to enact other forms of EU law would also fall away
